

Management (MANAGEMENT)

Course Description: This technical course encompasses material on the management process, management of resources, managing multiple roles within the life span, and career options and preparation. Content stresses knowledge and skills related to decision making, problem solving, and goal setting as management tools. Also addressed are effective practices for managing a wide range of resources including time, energy, environmental and financial resources; as well as technology, community, and human resources.

Facility and Resource Overview: This technical course utilizes an arrangement that accommodates development of Management essential knowledge and skills through locally selected instructional strategies. New instructional materials which address essential knowledge and skills for this course were adopted in November 2003.
