The Brain: Effects of Childhood Trauma

Highlights how trauma and threat adversely affect the developing brain. Research shows that trauma can activate various systems in the brain that change neuron response and cognitive pathways. Children that experience on-going high levels of arousal due to trauma will develop systems in their brains that cause them to be constantly hyper-aroused and hyper-vigilant. These changes can result in severe problems in learning ability, mood, bonding and attachment, and in problem-solving. Gives suggestions for avoiding and dealing with damage to the brain.
